

SUPREME ASSEMBLY SAVINGS PLAN

Virginia Rainbow has a new opportunity for girls and adults to start saving toward attending Supreme Assembly 2016 in Rhode Island.

Each person wishing to participate should submit funds to their local assembly for deposit. Local assemblies will issue a receipt to participant and funds should be deposited in the assembly bank account. Each assembly should maintain a record of participants and their deposits. These funds should be submitted to the Virginia Rainbow for Girls Foundation Treasurer by assembly check for all assembly participants for deposit on a bi-annual basis with a list detailing the amount per participant. Bi-annual deposits should be submitted by month end the months of October and April. Treasurer will issue a receipt to each assembly upon receipt of funds and maintain a savings ledger per participant.

Based on Supreme Assembly figures from 2014, each participant spent about \$215.00 which covered two nights hotel stay with four to a room, registration fee, banquet dinner and luncheon (girls, adults or grand cross). This would be a deposit to the savings plan of about \$12.00 per month for an eighteen month period per person. The amount can be any amount the participant wishes to deposit toward their Supreme Assembly savings.

If a participant finds that they are unable to attend Supreme Assembly 2016 they will have the option to keep the funds in the savings plan to use toward Supreme Assembly 2018 or have the funds refunded to them.

This is a great opportunity to put away a little at a time to help cover the cost of attending Supreme Assembly and our hope is that many will participate and take advantage of this savings plan. We want to have a large group attending Supreme Assembly 2016 and witness our very own Susan Rennagel be Installed as Supreme Worthy Advisor.
